



Train the Trainer 2018

Date and Class Hours

Class will start on Monday April 9 and conclude on Friday April 13, 2018. Start time will be 08:00 to 17:00 each day.

Cost and Meal Details

Class size will be limited 12 students and cost for the class is \$1000 USD per person. There are many restaurants nearby so lunches will be offsite and paid for by the student. As far as snacks, there is a coffee machine (free), snack machine (reasonable prices), and water bottles (free) on site.

Equipment

Students will be required to bring their own laptop in good working order. You will also be required to bring a mouse and have software pre-installed and working prior to arrival. We will send an email with more details about software requirements in March.

Curriculum

You will be taught the Map360 + Point certified training syllabus. This is a 40-hour class and will allow attendees to earn 40 ACTAR CEU's. Printed manuals will be provided prior to the start of the class.

Certified Trainer – Students enrolled to become certified trainers will be required to write a proficiency test and complete a short presentation to the entire class on a topic of their choice. Presentations will happen on Friday afternoon. Upon successful completion, students will receive a certificate certifying them as a certified Map360 trainer.

Certified User – Students enrolled to become certified users of Map360 will be required to write a proficiency test on Friday. Upon successful completion, students will receive a certificate certifying them as a certified Map360 user.

This is not an intro class to computers and forensic mapping. All students should have a certain level of proficiency before starting the class. Users should be familiar with simple computer operations and be familiar with basic forensic mapping and drafting principles. Prior experience with any of the following software programs will be beneficial: VistaFx, ARAS360, CadZone, FARO Zone3D, AutoCAD, AutoSketch, MapScenes, or IMS Map360.

If you are unsure if you meet this requirement, please contact Jason Poitras and he will assess your proficiency level to determine if this is the right class for you.
