



Train the Trainer 2019

Massachusetts State Police

Date and Class Hours

Class will start on Monday June 17th and conclude on Friday June 21st, 2019. Start time will be 08:00 to 17:00 each day except for Friday, which usually finishes around noon.

Cost and Meal Details

Class size will be limited to 10 students and cost for the class is \$1000 USD per person. There are many restaurants nearby, so lunches will be offsite and paid for by the student. Breakfast and evening dinners are also the responsibility of the student.

At the training facility, water and coffee is provided free of charge. There are no snacks available so bring your own if need it.

Equipment

Students will be required to bring their own laptop in good working order. You will also be required to bring a mouse and have software pre-installed and working prior to arrival. We will send an email with more details about software requirements in June.

Curriculum

You will be taught the Map360 + Point Cloud certified training syllabus. This is a 40-hour class and will allow attendees to earn 40 ACTAR CEU's. Printed manuals will be provided prior to the start of the class.

Certified Trainer – Students enrolled to become certified trainers will be required to write a proficiency test that includes a written test and a hands-on drawing exercise. Upon successful completion, students will receive a certificate certifying them as a certified Map360 trainer.

This is not an intro class to computers and forensic mapping. All students should have a minimum level of proficiency before starting the class. Users should be familiar with simple computer operations and be familiar with forensic mapping and drafting principles. Prior experience with any of the following software programs will be beneficial: VistaFx, ARAS360, CadZone, FARO Zone3D, AutoCAD, AutoSketch, MapScenes, or IMS Map360.

If you are unsure if you meet this requirement, please contact Jason Poitras and he will assess your proficiency level to determine if this is the right class for you.
